



**TERMS OF REFERENCE  
PROCUREMENT OF GOODS & SERVICES  
FOR ONE (1) YEAR CONTRACT ON THE SMOKE EMISSION COMPLIANCE TEST  
FOR ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN (177) VEHICLE UNITS  
OF SUBIC BAY METROPOLITAN AUTHORITY (SBMA)**

**I. BACKGROUND**

The Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) was created under the Bases Conversion and Development Act of 1992 (R.A. No. 7227) as an operating and implementing arm of the Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA). Among its mission are provisions of excellent customer services, provision of world class infrastructure and support services, balancing between development of environment, improvement of the quality of life and the encouragement of commercialization and regulatory strategies.

To meet the above objectives and to comply with government laws and directives, the SBMA expresses its desire, among others, to enter into a contractual arrangement with a private entity (Bidder) who shall, subject to terms and conditions set forth herewith, performed emission test by Land and Transportation (LTO) accredited Private Emission Testing Center (PETC) according to the Clean Air Act of 1999 (RA 8749), and collect relevant fees for its services.

This Terms of Reference (TOR) has been prepared to set basic and minimum conditions to guide the BIDDERS in preparation of their Bid/Tender Documents for the public bidding of the **ONE (1) YEAR CONTRACT ON THE SMOKE EMISSION COMPLIANCE TEST FOR ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN (177) VEHICLE UNITS OF SUBIC BAY METROPOLITAN AUTHORITY (SBMA)** in compliance to the Interim Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act no. 8749 otherwise known as "The Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999".

**II. OBJECTIVE**

In the mission to reduce our nation's carbon footprint, the Philippine government requires motor vehicles to undergo emission testing. This was put into law via Clean Air Act or R.A. 8749 which was enacted in 1999. As per aforementioned law, the government now monitors million of cars for the gasses they spewing into the atmosphere. To address this need for emissions testing a number of LTO accredited private testing centers are now spread all throughout the Philippines as one of the prerequisite for vehicle registration. The bid to be carried out-out shall be consistent

with the provision in the latest revised IRR of R.A. 9184 for goods and services including other applicable laws, rules and regulations.

### **III. SCOPE OF WORKS / AREA OF COVERAGE**

The project is described as the provision of performing Emission Test for One Hundred Seventy-Seven (177) vehicles units of Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) in compliance with the Land and Transportation Office vehicle registration requirements.

### **IV. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

#### **a. THE BIDDER**

1. The bidder must be included in the list of LTO accredited smoke emission testing center.
2. Their open-air facility with two lanes must be located with-in the freeport zone area.
3. The bidder shall accept SBMA terms and conditions of payment.

#### **b. KEY PERSONNEL**

The key personnel of the prospective bidder must have at least one (1) year experience similar or related to the subject project.

#### **c. FINANCIAL CAPABILITY**

The prospective Project bidder must show proof that it has adequate capability to sustain the financing requirements for the project in accordance to the requirements as prescribed in RA 9184 and its IRR.

### **V. APPROVED BUDGET OF THE CONTRACT (ABC) AND CONTRACT DURATION**

The ABC for the proposed goods and services is Seventy-Seven Eight Hundred Eighty Philippine pesos (PHP 77,880.00) annually sourced from SBMA Corporate Operating Budget for FY 2023-2024.

The Contract duration shall be valid for One (1) year starting from the date of Notice to proceed (NTP).

### **VI. OBLIGATION AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### **a. THE BIDDER**

1. The bidder must perform emission test on all One hundred Seventy-seven (177) SBMA owned service vehicles before their registrations can be renewed, according to the Clean Air Act of 1999 (RA 8749).
2. The bidder shall provide a print out of emission test result before the registration of each vehicle.

b. SUBIC BAY METROPOLITAN AUTHORITY (SBMA)

1. SBMA shall be responsible for endorsing list of SBMA vehicles scheduled for emission test before registration to LTO.
2. SBMA shall pay the Private Entity based on agreed amount stipulated in the winning bid every 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month after submission of the complete documents (monthly billing statement/ monthly service report etc.) as stipulated herein.

**VII. BID PROPOSAL / BASIS FOR EVALUATION AND AWARD**

All bids shall be based on a unit cost per vehicle emission tested, inclusive of all capital expenditures, direct cost and incidental expenses.

The scope of the bid price shall include professional fees and other miscellaneous expenses. Please note that SBMA is VAT free.

Evaluation and award of contract shall be in accordance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its IRR for the Procurement of Goods and Services.

**VIII. PAYMENT TERMS AND SCHEDULE**

The Private Entity shall submit a monthly billing statement every 5th day of the month detailing the fees as stated below as the basis of payment in accordance to the delivery of outputs as stated herein:

- i. Emission Test per unit on a Monthly Billing - Php \_\_\_\_\_ / unit.

**IX. GROUNDS FOR TERMINATION**

A cumulative number of fifteen (15) counts of violation of the private entity shall be sufficient grounds for termination of contract. The performance shall be based on the inspection work done and evaluation of the requirement to be conducted by the SBMA Maintenance and Transportation Department who shall be the duly authorized representative of SBMA. Likewise, any violation of SBMA rules and Regulation and

other applicable rules and regulation of other government agencies shall be grounds for termination.

SBMA shall have the option to terminate the contract anytime during its effective term should SBMA is not satisfied with the contractor's services.

**X. PERFORMANCE SECURITY**

To guarantee the faithful performance of the Private Entity for its responsibilities and obligations under the Contract, and the payment to SBMA for losses, and/or damages suffered thereby and such other liabilities that the Private Entity may have incurred during its duty arising from unsatisfactory performance or non-performance under the Contract, the Private Entity shall post a performance security in favor of SBMA in the form of Cash, Cashier's or Manager's Check (equivalent to 5% of the ABC) or Surety Bond (equivalent to 30% of the ABC).


The performance bond shall be callable on demand and shall have a validity period equal to the duration of the contract including its renewal or extension. Should the losses, damages or liabilities exceed the Cash Bond or Surety Bond, the Private Entity shall continue to be liable for the difference until SBMA is fully paid.

**XI. RESERVATION CLAUSE**

The Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) reserves the right to accept or reject any goods and services rendered, to annul the bid process and to reject at any time without thereby incurring any liability to the contractor.
