IX. Sampling and Monitoring Report. Winning service provider shall bill the SBMA 10 days after the submission of the Quarterly Water Analysis Report, following the report format labeled as ANNEX A, and acceptance by the SBMA Ecology Center of the said report. All Photo-documentations in each sampling stations taken during actual sampling shall have a GPS reading and included in the report.
